1. Everyone is fighting a battle



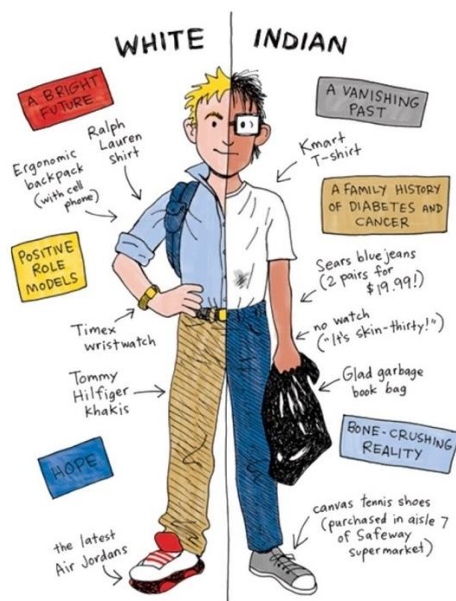

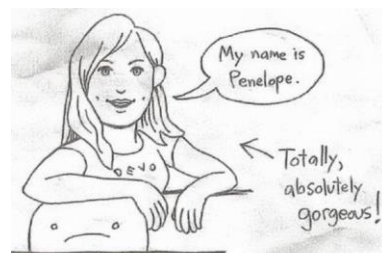
2. As time goes by...

Imagine you are Arnold Spirit Jr. Several years have passed since you wrote your diary. Write a blog post in which you remember and discuss your childhood and teenage relationships with others. Your post should be guided by the following cues:

- Choose a character from the novel and explain how and why he/she (has) influenced you or your life. Present the way(s) you, Arnold, (have) affected somebody else's life. Explain how and why.
- Reflect on how your childhood and teenage relationships helped you become the person you are now and justify your thoughts.
- Finish your post by presenting your views on the importance (or lack of it) of being in different types of relationship. Support your ideas with an example or two.



Write your composition which should contain 250-300 words. Where appropriate, use the information from the novel. And remember, you are Arnold. Your composition will be marked on content (5 points), vocabulary and spelling (5 points), grammar (5 points), and organisation (5 points).
